THE AD CLUB & SPORTSTAR TWENTY/20 CRICKET TOURNAMENT 2008

RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1) All the matches in this tournament shall be played under the twenty20 rules and the BCCI Law subject to all laws of cricket now appealed by the ICC and implemented by the Advertising Club Madras, organizers of this tournament, subject to the special playing conditions prescribed by their rules.
- 2) Any of the existing rules can be altered, amended or cancelled as considered appropriate by the tournament committee.
- 3) All teams selected to participate in this tournament shall submit a list of 14 players along with their passport size photos. In case of injury to players, change can be made only after acquiring consent from the tournament committee and the umpires.
- 4) Only players from II, III, IV & V division of TNCA league will be permitted to play in the tournament.
- 5) Liquor is strictly prohibited on the ground and if it is found the teams will be debarred from the tournament without any prior notice. No refund will be given by the tournament committee.
- 6) The matches will be held on Saturdays, Sundays and on government holidays only.
- 7) Rematch will not be allowed if any team does not agree to umpires' decisions and stages a walk out while the match is in progress. If a team stages a walk over, then they will lose (2 + 2) Points and if the same team stages a walkover for the second time then they will be debarred from the tournament with immediate effect.
- 8) The decision of Ad Club Madras committee will be final in all matters and their authority cannot be questioned either before any tribunal or any court of law.
- 9) The matches will be played in three sessions i.e. 7-30 am to 10-30 am, 10- 45 am to 1-45 pm, & 2-15 pm to 5-15 pm.
- 10) Each bowler will be allowed a maximum of four overs only.
- 11) Two points will be awarded to the winning team.
- 12) Before the toss, the two playing captains should produce their list of 11 players to the umpires and no alteration will be allowed thereafter.
- 13) Teams should bring full kit bag with first aid box.
- 14) "Power play "will be allowed only in the first six overs of each innings.

- 15) In the event of a tie, or in the event of the match being washed out due to rain, a "bowl out" will decide the winner.
- 16) The "bowl out" will be conducted on any part of the ground that the umpires deem fit
- 17) Five players from each team, who are in the nominated eleven, will bowl one delivery each at the stumps (without the batsman).
- 18) Victory will go to the team with most hits. If the "bowl out" cannot decide the winner, the teams will go into "sudden death", and if that too does not decide a winners, then the victor will be decided by the spin of a coin.
- 19) Only two fielders are allowed outside the 30 yard circle in the first six overs. After six overs, a minimum of 4 fielders plus the keeper and bowler should remain inside the 30 yard circle, if this rule is not followed a "no ball" will be called and one run will be awarded to the opponent. In case the bowler over steps, two runs will awarded to the opponents team.
- 20) A fast, high, full pitched ball shall be defined as a ball that passes or would have passed in full above the waist height of a batsman standing upright at the crease. Should a bowler bowl a fast, high, full pitched ball, either umpire can signal a "No ball".
 - a. There shall be not more than five fieldsmen on the onside at the time of delivery (throughout the match) and not more than two behind the popping crease on the onside (throughout the match).
 - b. In the event of an infringement the square leg umpire shall call and signal "No ball".
 - c. One bouncer will be allowed per over & a signal will be indicated to the Bowler.
- 21) Points in the tournament will be given as follows:
 - a) Two points will be awarded to the winning team.
 - b) During the league matches, in case rain prevents the match from being played, the points will be shared by both teams (one point each).
 - c) In case rain interrupts play, 10 overs of second half will be taken and an average will be calculated taking into account the Douglas Louis method - better run rate & fall of wickets and the team with the higher average will be awarded two points.
 - d) In the knock out stage, if rain derails start of play, an alternate date for play will be issued by the committee. If rain yet again interrupts play, the spin of the coin will decide the winner.
- 22) Team should maintain timing before start of the match strictly otherwise penalty will be awarded by the match referee. The fielding team is allotted 90 minutes - if this is not adhered to, a late bowling team penalty of 5 runs per over will be strictly followed by the match referee.

- 23) **Team must ensure that they submit their list of players to the match referee atleast 30 minutes before the start of play- late submission will evoke penalty.**
- 24) **NO FREE HIT will be allowed under any circumstances on a NO BALL.**
